Where do we learn faith? At home! BLAST is here to help make that happen. If we want Christian children and youth, we need Christian adults to show them how it's done. But where do we start? A big part is reading the Bible and talking about it together as a family. BLAST is a low-key, back-to-the-basics look at the same lessons being learned in BibleLand, with some tips on how to talk about those lessons together as a family when you go home.



Who: Especially for BibleLand parents, but open to everyone high school and up

What: Spend one half hour the first week of each BibleLand rotation (once every three weeks) looking at the BibleLand lesson as adults, hearing about how the kids are learning it, and going home with some ideas on how to talk about it together.

When: In between services, after BibleLand opening time, starting September 13th. You'll get email reminders before each session. Don't worry about missing one – each time is a brand new topic!

Where: Some weeks in the big BibleLand room, other weeks someplace else, like a restaurant. We'll figure it out as we go!
