*Mary* will be giving a report about her trip during the worship service next week. Don't miss it!

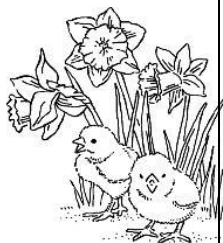


## Easter Lilies
