Nursery Care is available during both the 9:00 & 10:30 a.m. service. The Infant Nursery is for ages 0-18 months and is located on the *main* level, north hallway. The Toddler Nursery is for 19-36 months and is located on the *lower* level, north hallway. Pagers are provided.

M&M's Children's Ministry (Music & More) takes place at 9:00 a.m. for ages K-5th grade.

S.H.O.U.T. Children's Ministry takes place during the 10:30 service. Ages 1st-5th grade begin the hour in the sanctuary with their family and are dismissed to SHOUT after Praise and Prayer.

Critter Land takes place during the 10:30 a.m. service. The 3 yr. olds meet in the north east classroom on the lower level. The 4 yrs.-K meet in the north east room next to the sanctuary.
