

DEAD MAN LIVES AGAIN (Ezekiel 37:1-14)

Study Questions

1. What misconceptions of revival do you think people have?
2. Read through Ezekiel 37:1-14
3. How would you summarize the main idea of this passage?
4. Who is addressed in revival (37:11,13)
 - Are you 100% certain that you have been born of the Spirit of God? Do you have any doubt whatsoever that you are a born again Christian? What “fruit” exists in your life that you have been born again?
5. When is revival needed (36:17-18; 37:1)?
 - Are you in need of spiritual revival? What indications exist in your life that might point to the need for a fresh touch of God in your life?
 - God takes disobedience to His Word (sin) seriously! Is there any conduct or actions in your life that is out of step with God’s Word? How can we pray for you? Take time to pray right now for the needs that are presented.
6. What means does God use in order to bring revival to our lives (37:3-14)
 - How committed are you to placing yourself under these means of grace to seek God for revival? What specifically will you commit yourself to do this coming week?
7. In revival, our relationship with God becomes healthy again (36:24-28, 31-32).
 - How vibrant is your personal relationship with Christ right now? When was the last time you grieved over your own sin? When was the last time you confessed a specific sin to God? Is there some sin you need to confess to God?
8. In revival, our relationships with other people become healthy again.
 - Are there any strained or broken relationships in your life that need your attention? What steps do you need to take in order to restore these strained or broken relationships?
9. In revival, a greater witness for Christ takes place among non-Christians (36:23)
 - Are you regularly sharing the gospel of Christ with others? If not, what might this be an indication of?

Close in a time of prayer. Pray specifically for each other and the needs that have been shared. Ask God to place a hunger and thirst in your life for personal revival. Pray for our entire church, that God would revive us.
