Presentation of Baptismal Chests

At this time I would like to invite those children celebrating the anniversary of their baptisms to come forward with their parents and sponsors as your names are read.

Leader: Parents and Sponsors, when you presented these children for baptism, you were entrusted with these responsibilities: to bring them to worship so that they might hear God's Word and one day participate in the Lord's Supper, as well as to nurture them in faith and prayer, so that they may learn to love and trust God. Do you remember the commitments you made?

Let them ever rejoice in the gift you have given them. Strengthen them in their own baptism so that they might be teachers for their own children. We pray in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord.
