## **2011 Faith Lutheran Mission Trip**

**Destination: Green Bay, Wisconsin**

**Dates: July 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> – Note: this is over the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday.**

**Cost: \$200 approximately, depending on Mission Trip fundraising donations**

**Eligible: Current 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, & 8<sup>th</sup> grade students**

*As quoted from YouthWorks:*

*Green Bay, Wisconsin has all the amenities of a big city, but offers the simple pleasures and relaxed pace of a smaller town. The Green Bay of Lake Michigan, for which the city is named, offers a beautiful setting to bask in the sun. While the city has been consistently recognized as a great place to live, this is not the case for all residents. There still are those who struggle with poverty and even homelessness.*

*Through ministry at homeless shelters and through outreach to both children and the elderly, your group will have a unique opportunity to shine the light of Christ into the darker parts of this city. Participants serve in a variety of ways during a YouthWorks mission trip. Students may spend all week at one ministry or switch between ministries during the week. Our goal is to partner with local organizations and programs that seek to address the very basic needs of residents. Students may serve at places like: Children's Programs, Elderly Centers, Soup Kitchens/Homeless Shelters and Thrift Stores. We cannot confirm until all groups arrive exactly what ministries your students will be a part of during the week. We ask that you come with a willing and flexible spirit!*

*Evening activities during a YouthWorks week are designed to give participants an insight into the lives of local residents and the culture of the area. A list of evening/cultural activities we have done in the past include: taking part in a community prayer drive through the city; visit Bay Beach amusement park; visit the Packer's Hall of Fame; and attend a community cookout. These are examples of what your group might partake in during your mission week. These examples are subject to change due to weather or availability. In case of change, suitable substitutes will be provided. We try to arrange for free evening activities, but from time to time, an additional cost may be required for an activity. Please plan to bring an additional \$10 per person to cover any extra costs. We will confirm the details closer to your trip*

If you would like to sign-up to attend or would like more information, please contact Pastor Justin or return the bottom part of this form as soon as possible. Must be signed up by **February 11<sup>th</sup>** and paid a \$60 deposit. We have a limit on how many may attend.

## **New Member Mentor**

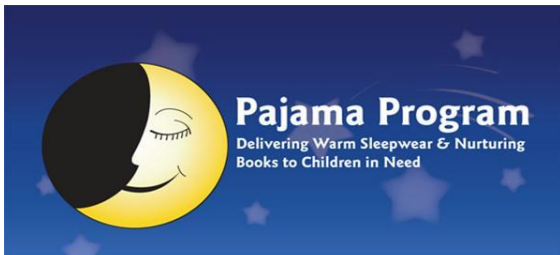
