2011 Service Books: Our new service books are ready. Anyone who would like a 2011 Service Book can pick one up on the table in the Narthex.

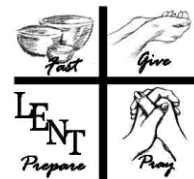
Youth
