

FAQs

1. Is it biblical? Yes. In Paul's letter to the Corinthians, he clearly supports consistent, proportional giving when he instructs God's people to: set aside a sum of money in keeping with his income, on the first day of every week. *(1 Corinthians 16:2)*

2. With EFT Payment, can MCN obtain confidential information about me? No. Only the information on the written Authorization Form you sign to begin the EFT process is available to MCN. We do not have access to your account balance or any other information about you this maintained by your financial institution.

3. Why must I send a voided check when I sign up for EFT? We need a check or deposit slip to obtain accurate information regarding the financial institution and customer account number in order to collect the payment electronically.

4. Can I stop payment or cancel enrollment? Yes. Simply inform MCN in writing that you want to stop participating. You can also suspend payments if needed.

5. Is electronic contribution risky? Electronic contribution is less risky than check contribution. It cannot be lost, stolen or destroyed in the mail. It has an extremely high rate of accuracy.

6. What if I change bank accounts or want to change the amount of my contribution? Notify us and fill out a new Authorization form and return it to the church.

7. How much does EFT cost? It cost you nothing and saves you time.

8. Is there a risk of identity theft? No. The information you give us will be securely stored and will not be shared.

9. Is MCN working with a third party processor? No. Your EFT is initiated by MCN through our bank, so directives are between you and MCN only.

EFT

In this age of technology, Electronic Funds Transfers (EFT) has become more and more common and convenient. EFT is safe, secure, efficient, and less expensive than paper check payments. This convenient method of making contributions through automatic electronic deductions from your saving or checking account will establish a consistent and orderly pattern of giving important for ministries a Marysville Church of the Nazarene. To use EFT, a written Authorization Form is required. To enroll in the program, simply fill out this form and bring it/mail it to the church office.

How it Works: According to your instructions, MCN will instruct your financial institutions to deduct the amount you choose from your account. Your financial institution then withdraws that amount and forwards it electronically to the church's account. The payment will be shown on your monthly account statement from your financial institution and your annual statement from the church.
