INTRODUCTION

Hebrews 1:1-3 (NIV) In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, [2] but in these last days he has **spoken to us by his Son**, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe. [3] The **Son is the radiance of God's glory** and the exact representation of his being, **sustaining all things by his powerful word**. After he had **provided PURIFICATION for sins**, he **SAT DOWN at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven**.

PRAY FOR ME ~ Hebrews 13:18-19

[18] Pray for us. We are sure that we have a clear conscience and desire to live honorably in every way. [19] I particularly urge you to pray so that I may be restored to you soon.

PRAY - So THAT I...

- can continue to live HONORABLY
- may be RESTORED to you

APPLICATION

Conscience - is our sense of Right and Wrong Encarta

Hebrews 4:12-13 (NIV) For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. [13] Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

Hebrews 4:14-16 (NIV) Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has gone through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. [15] For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are--yet was without sin. [16] Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

EQUIPPED WITH EVERYTHING GOOD ~ Hebrews 13:20-21

[20] May the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep,

Hebrews 10:11-14 (NIV) Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. [12] But **when THIS PRIEST had offered FOR ALL TIME ONE SACRIFICE for sins, HE SAT DOWN at the right hand of God**. [13] Since that time he waits for his enemies to be made his footstool, [14] because by one sacrifice he **has made PERFECT FOREVER** those who are being made holy.

Hebrews 6:19-20 (NIV) We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain, [20] where Jesus, who went before us, has entered on our behalf. He has become a high priest forever, in the order of Melchizedek.
