

## **GOD POURS OUT HIS BLESSINGS ON JOSEPH ~ Genesis 39:1-21**

### **INTRODUCTION**

### **POTIPHAR is BLESSED Because of JOSEPH ~ Genesis 39:1-6**

[1] Now Joseph had been taken down to Egypt. Potiphar, an Egyptian who was one of Pharaoh's officials, the captain of the guard, bought him from the Ishmaelites who had taken him there. [2] The Lord was with Joseph and he prospered, and he lived in the house of his Egyptian master. [3] When his master saw that the Lord was with him and that the Lord gave him success in everything he did, [4] Joseph found favor in his eyes and became his attendant. Potiphar put him IN CHARGE of his household, and he ENTRUSTED to his care EVERYTHING he OWNED. [5] From the time he put him IN CHARGE of his household and of all that he owned, the Lord BLESSED the household of the Egyptian because of Joseph. The blessing of the Lord was on everything Potiphar had, both in the HOUSE and in the FIELD. [6] So he LEFT in Joseph's care everything he had; with Joseph in charge, he did not concern himself with anything except the food he ate...

### **APPLICATION**

#### **BLESSINGS FOR A SLAVE**

- SERVED in the house vs. 2
- personal ATTENDANT to Potiphar vs. 4
- OVERSEER - administrator vs. 5

#### **WHY DID GOD BLESS JOSEPH?**

- God is FAITHFUL and Keeps ALL His PROMISES
- God Blessed his OBEDIENCE and FAITHFULNESS

**Deuteronomy 31:6** (NIV) Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your **God goes with you; HE will NEVER leave you nor forsake you.**

### **SEVERE - DAILY - TEMPTATION ~ Genesis 39:6-10**

...Now Joseph was well-built and handsome, [7] and after a while his master's wife took notice of Joseph and said, "Come to bed with me!" [8] But he REFUSED. "With me in charge," he told her, "my master does not concern himself with anything in the house; everything he owns he has ENTRUSTED to my care. [9] No one is GREATER in this house than I am. My master has withheld nothing from me except you, because you are his wife. How then could I do such a wicked thing and SIN AGAINST GOD?" [10] And though she spoke to Joseph day after day, he REFUSED to go to bed with her OR even BE WITH HER.

#### **WHY JOSEPH SAID NO**

- an Abuse of TRUST
- OFFENSE against Potiphar
- SIN against God

## APPLICATION

### FALSE ACCUSATION AND IMPRISONMENT ~ Genesis 39:11-20

[11] One day he went into the house to attend to his duties, and none of the household servants was inside. [12] She caught him by his cloak and said, "Come to bed with me!" But he left his cloak in her hand and ran out of the house. [13] When she saw that he had left his cloak in her hand and had run out of the house, [14] she called her household servants. "Look," she said to them, "this Hebrew has been brought to us to make sport of us! He came in here to sleep with me, but I screamed. [15] When he heard me scream for help, he left his cloak beside me and ran out of the house." [16] She kept his cloak beside her until his master came home. [17] Then she told him this story: "That Hebrew slave you brought us came to me to make sport of me. [18] But as soon as I screamed for help, he left his cloak beside me and ran out of the house." [19] When his master heard the story his wife told him, saying, "This is how YOUR SLAVE treated me," he BURNED with ANGER. [20] Joseph's master took him and put him in prison, the place where the king's prisoners were confined. But while Joseph was there in the prison, [21] the Lord was WITH him; he showed him kindness and granted him favor in the eyes of the prison warden.

## APPLICATION

**1 Corinthians 10:13** (NLT) The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure.

### FOR VICTORY OVER TEMPTATION WE MUST...

- Know that it is WRONG
- Be Committed to Honoring God by OBEDIENCE
- AVOID Places of Temptation
- Look for the ESCAPE
- Turn Away and RUN

➔ Watch out the more you look at a TEMPTATION the better it looks
