

## BEING MADE HOLY ~ Hebrews 10:1-14

→ Scripture Reading Heb. 10:1, 4, 10-14

### THE OLD SYSTEM DID NOT WORK ~ Hebrews 9:1-4

[1] The law is only a shadow of the good things that are coming--not the realities themselves. For this reason it can never, by the same sacrifices repeated endlessly year after year, make perfect those who draw near to worship. [2] If it could, would they not have stopped being offered? For the worshipers would have been cleansed once for all, and would no longer have felt guilty for their sins. [3] But those sacrifices are an annual reminder of sins, [4] because it is IMPOSSIBLE for the blood of bulls and goats to TAKE AWAY sins.

### APPLICATION

**ATONEMENT = the covering over of sin, the reconciliation between God and man through the death of Jesus Christ** Unger's

#### FINAL ATONEMENT Unger

- is found only **THROUGH** Jesus John 3:14-15
- is necessary for **SALVATION** Acts 4:12
- is an **COMPLETED** fact Heb.9:26-28
- showed a **WRATH** of a Holy God **AGAINST** sin Matt. 27:45-46
- showed the **LOVE** of a **GRACIOUS** God towards sinners John 3:16
- is **OFFERED** to **ALL** 1 Timothy 2:5-6
- is not **APPLIED** automatically to **ALL** John 3:36

#### YOU CAN REST BECAUSE YOU....

- are **FORGIVEN**
- **BELONG** to Christ
- have the Holy Spirit **LIVING** in you
- have direct **ACCESS** to God at **ALL** times

### THROUGH JESUS WE ARE MADE HOLY ~ Hebrews 9:5-10

[5] Therefore, when Christ came into the world, he said: "Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but a body you prepared for me; [6] with burnt offerings and sin offerings you were not pleased. [7] Then I said, 'Here I am- it is written about me in the scroll - I have come to do your will, O God.'" [8] First he said, "Sacrifices and offerings, burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not desire, nor were you pleased with them" (although the law required them to be made). [9] Then he said, "Here I am, I have come to do your will." He sets aside the first to establish the second. [10] And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ ONCE for all.

## POSITIONAL AND PRACTICAL HOLINESS ~ Hebrews 9:5-10

[11] Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. [12] But when this priest had offered for all time one sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God. [13] Since that time he waits for his enemies to be made his footstool, [14] because by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy.

## APPLICATION

**Positional Sanctification** - God sees me AS HOLY

**Progressive Sanctification** - God gives me Grace to keep on growing in Holiness

**Final Sanctification** - changed completely when we see Jesus

**Titus 2:11-14 (ESV)** For the **GRACE** of God has appeared, bringing **salvation** for all people, [12] **TRAINING us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age**, [13] waiting for our **BLESSED HOPE**, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, [14] who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

**FREE FROM...** LIFE APP.COM

**PENALTY** of sin - Jesus paid it all

**POWER** of sin - Jesus conquered Sin and Death

**NOT FREE FROM...**

**PRESENCE** of sin - is all around

**POSSIBILITY** of sin - we face temptation daily

## TAKE AWAY ??

**Hebrews 7:27 (NIV)** Unlike the other high priests, he does not need to offer sacrifices day after day, first for his own sins, and then for the sins of the people. He sacrificed for their sins **ONCE FOR ALL** when he offered himself.

**Hebrews 9:12 (NIV)** He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place **ONCE FOR ALL by his own blood**, having obtained eternal redemption

**Hebrews 9:26 (NIV)** Then Christ would have had to suffer many times since the creation of the world. But now he has appeared **ONCE FOR ALL** at the end of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself.

**Hebrews 9:27-28 (NIV)** Just as man is destined to die once, and after that to face judgment, [28] so Christ was **SACRIFICED ONCE** to take away the sins of many people; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him.

**Hebrews 10:10 (NIV)** And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ **ONCE FOR ALL**.

**Hebrews 10:12-14 (NIV)** But when this priest had offered for **ALL TIME ONE SACRIFICE** for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God. [13] Since that time he waits for his enemies to be made his footstool, [14] because by **ONE SACRIFICE** he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy.
