[6] The LORD was grieved that he had made man on the earth, and his heart was filled with pain. [7] So the LORD said, "I will wipe mankind, whom I have created, from the face of the earth--men and animals, and creatures that move along the ground, and birds of the air - for I am grieved that I have made them."

**Gen. 6:5** (MSG) GOD saw that human evil was out of control. People thought evil, imagined evil - evil, evil, evil from morning to night

**Gen. 6:11** (NIV) Now the earth was CORRUPT in God's sight and was FULL of VIOLENCE.

**Gen. 6:17** (NIV) I am going to bring floodwaters on the earth to destroy all life under the heavens, every creature that has the breath of life in it. Everything on earth will perish.

[8] But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD. [9] This is the account of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked with God.

## **AFTER THE FLOOD - Genesis 8:20-22**

### **There is always a cost to GRACE**
