What goes around....

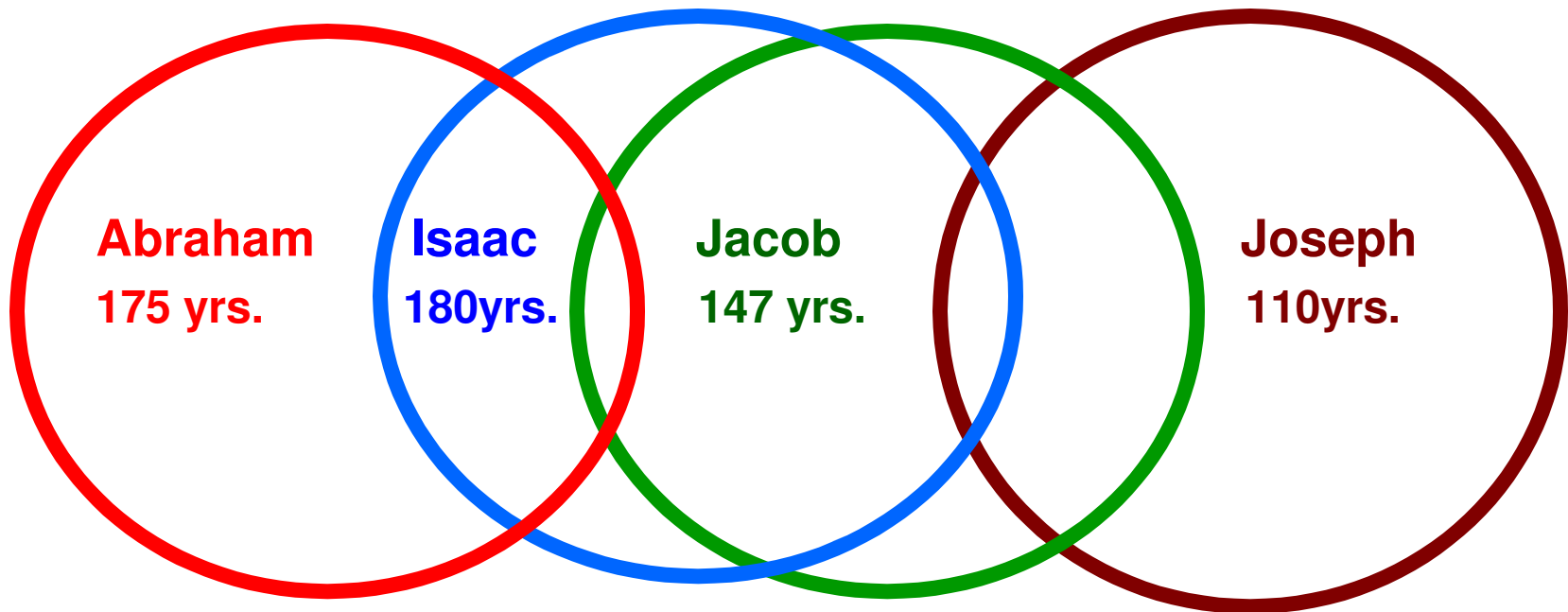
...comes around
