**[10] Jacob left Beersheba and set out for Haran. [11] When he reached a certain place, he stopped for the night because the sun had set. Taking one of the stones there, he put it under his head and lay down to sleep.**

## **Genesis 28:12 (NIV)**

**[12] He had a dream in which he saw a stairway resting on the earth, with its top reaching to heaven, and the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.**

**Genesis 28:13 (NIV)**

**[13] There above it stood the LORD,  
and he said: "I am the LORD, the  
God of your father Abraham and the  
God of Isaac. I will give you and  
your descendants the land on which  
you are lying.**

## **Genesis 28:14 (NIV)**

**[14] Your descendants will be like the dust of the earth, and you will spread out to the west and to the east, to the north and to the south. All peoples on earth will be blessed through you and your offspring.**

**Genesis 28:15 (NIV)**

**[15] I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you."**

**Genesis 48:1 - 49:28**

Jacob did NOT talk about the  
difficulties of his life  
instead he spoke **about God Almighty**  
and what **God had DONE** for him.

- promise **MAKER**
- my **SHEPHERD**
- my **PROTECTOR**
- promise **KEEPER**

# **Jacob Taught his Family to**

- Worship **ONLY** God
- Believe the **PROMISES** of God
- **OBEY** the things God Commanded

Deuteronomy 6:4-6 (ESV)

“Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. [5] You shall **LOVE the LORD your God with ALL your heart and with ALL your soul and with ALL your might.** [6] And these words that I command you today **SHALL be ON your HEART.**

Deuteronomy 6:7-9 (ESV)

**You shall teach them DILIGENTLY to your children,** and shall **TALK** of them when you **SIT** in your house, and when you **WALK** by the way, and when you **LIE DOWN,** and when you **RISE.**

[8] You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.

[9] You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

Galatians 6:7 (NET)

attitudes, and actions is constantly

**PLANTING for a future REAPING.**
