**Immutability- God Never Changes

Personality. (B. Bill)**

Immutability - God does Not Change. This does not mean that He is immobile or inactive. However, He is never inconsistent or growing or developing. (C. Ryrie)

Numbers 23:19 (NIV)

God is not a man, that he should lie, nor a son of man, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?

Malachi 3:6 (NIV)

**I the LORD do not change. So you, O
descendants of Jacob, are not
destroyed.**

Jonah 3:4-5 (NIV)

On the first day, Jonah started into the city. He proclaimed: "Forty more days and Nineveh will be overturned." [5] The Ninevites believed God. They declared a fast, and all of them, from the greatest to the least, put on sackcloth.

Jonah 3: 10 (NIV)

When God saw what they did and how they turned from their evil ways, he had compassion and did not bring upon them the destruction he had threatened.

Genesis 6:5-6 (NASU)

Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. [6] The LORD was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart.

1 Samuel 15:10-11 (NASU)

Then the word of the LORD came to Samuel, saying, [11] "I regret that I have made Saul king, for he has turned back from following Me and has not carried out My commands..."

John 3:16-17 (NIV)

1 Kings 8:56 (NIV)
