Psalms 139:1-3

O LORD, you have searched me and you know me. [2] You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. [3] You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways.

Psalms 139:4-6

**[4] Before a word is on my tongue
you know it completely, O LORD. [5]
You hem me in--behind and before;
you have laid your hand upon me. [6]
Such knowledge is too wonderful for
me, too lofty for me to attain.**

Psalms 103:14

**...for he knows how we are formed,
he remembers that we are dust.**

**Knowledge = a body of truth, information,
or principles... learned or experienced**

**Knowledge = all that you have ever learned
or experienced (& still remember)**

1- God's Knowledge is INFINITE

Psalms 147:4-5 He determines the number of the stars and calls them each by name. [5] Great is our Lord and mighty in power; HIS understanding has no limit.

→ God's knowledge has NO LIMITS

2- God's Knowledge is INTUITIVE

Isaiah 40:12-14 Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, or with the breadth of his hand marked off the heavens? Who has held the dust of the earth in a basket, or weighed the mountains on the scales and the hills in a balance? [13] Who has understood the mind of the LORD, or instructed him as his counselor? [14] Whom did the LORD consult to enlighten him, and who taught him the right way? Who was it that taught him knowledge or showed him the path of understanding?

→ He NEVER has to LEARN Anything...
HE has Always Known Everything

3- God's Knowledge EXTENDS from the Past, Present, Future, & What Might have Been

Matthew 11:21 Woe to you, Korazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! If the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes.

→ God Knows All things Past, Present, Future or Possible

4- God's Knowledge is PERSONAL

He Knows us better than we Know Ourselves

Psalms 103:14

**...for he knows how we are formed,
he remembers that we are dust.**

- **my every action**
- **all my thoughts**
- **all my ways**
- **my words before I speak them**
- **my limitations**

→ God's Knowledge of us is PERSONAL ...
He knows us better than we Know Ourselves

1- God's Knowledge Should Encourage us in Prayer

Matthew 6:6-8 But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you. [7] And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. [8] Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

Matthew 6:31-33 So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' [32] For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. [33] But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

**→ Because God KNOWS Everything...
...He Answers Prayer PERFECTLY**

God's Knowledge - a Comfort During Trials

God knows...

...and Understands ALL my Weaknesses

Hebrews 4:15-16 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are--yet was without sin. [16] Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

God's Knowledge - a Comfort During Trials

God knows...

...every one of my Trials, Tests, or
Temptations - Past, Present, Future

Job 23:10 But he knows the way that I take; when he
has tested me, I will come forth as gold.

God's Knowledge - a Comfort During Trials

God knows...

...my limits and how much I can handle

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.

God's Knowledge - a Comfort During Trials

God knows...

...His promises and He has the power to fulfill them

2 Peter 2:9 So you see, the Lord knows how to rescue godly people from their trials, even while punishing the wicked right up until the day of judgment. (NLT)

**→ Because God KNOWS Everything
I Can Trust Him to Work in in My Life**

3- God is sovereign over his knowledge

Jeremiah 31:34 No longer will a man teach his neighbor, or a man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest," declares the LORD. "For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins **NO more."**

Psalms 103:11-12

For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him; [12] as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.

Psalms 139:23-24

Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. [24] See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.
