

Hebrews 10:1 (NLT)

[1] The old system under the law of Moses was only a shadow, a dim preview of the good things to come, not the good things themselves. The sacrifices under that system were repeated again and again, year after year, but they were never able to provide perfect cleansing for those who came to worship.

Hebrews 10:4 (NLT)

[4] For it is not possible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

Hebrews 10:11-12 (NLT)

[11] Under the old covenant, the priest stands and ministers before the altar day after day, offering the same sacrifices again and again, which can never take away sins. [12] But our High Priest offered himself to God as a single sacrifice for sins, good for all time. Then he sat down in the place of honor at God's right hand.

Hebrews 10:13-14 (NLT)

[13] There he waits until his enemies are humbled and made a footstool under his feet. [14] For by that one offering he forever made perfect those who are being made holy.

Being Made HOLY

Hebrews 10:1-14

the covering over of sin
the reconciliation between
God and man
through
the DEATH of Jesus Christ

FINAL ATONEMENT Unger

- is found only **THROUGH** Jesus
- is necessary for **SALVATION**
- is an **COMPLETED** fact
- showed the **WRATH** of a Holy God **AGAINST** sin
- showed the **LOVE** of a **GRACIOUS** God towards sinners
- is **OFFERED** to **ALL**
- is **NOT APPLIED** automatically to **ALL**

You can REST Because you....

- **are FORGIVEN**
- **BELONG** to Christ
- have the Holy Spirit **LIVING** in you
- have direct **ACCESS** to God at **ALL** times

**The sacrifice Lamb has been slain His
blood on the Altar a Stain**

**To wipe away guilt and Shame to
Bring Hope Eternal**

So **Final Atonement has come, And
brought us new hope by God's Son**

**If you will believe in your heart,
Yeshua (Jesus) you know.**

Positional Sanctification - God sees me
AS HOLY

Progressive Sanctification - God gives me
Grace to keep on growing in Holiness

Final Sanctification - changed completely
when we see Jesus

Titus 2:11-14 (ESV)

For the **GRACE** of God has appeared, **bringing salvation for all people**, [12] **TRAINING** us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, [13] **waiting for our BLESSED HOPE**, the **appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ**, [14] who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

Free From...

PENALTY of sin - Jesus paid it all

POWER of sin - Jesus conquered Sin
and Death

Not Free From...

PRESENCE of sin - is all around

POSSIBILITY of sin - we face
temptation daily

Hebrews 7:27 (NIV)

Unlike the other high priests, he does not need to offer sacrifices day after day, first for his own sins, and then for the sins of the people. He sacrificed for their sins **ONCE FOR ALL** when he offered himself.

Hebrews 9:12 (NIV)

He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place **ONCE FOR ALL** by his own blood, **having obtained eternal redemption...**

Hebrews 9:26 (NIV)

Then Christ would have had to suffer many times since the creation of the world. But now he has appeared **ONCE FOR ALL** at the end of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself.

Hebrews 9:27-28 (NIV)

Just as man is destined to die once, and after that to face judgment, [28] so Christ was **SACRIFICED ONCE** to take away the sins of many people; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him.

Hebrews 10:10 (NIV)

**And by that will, we have been made holy
through the sacrifice
of the body of Jesus Christ
ONCE FOR ALL.**

Hebrews 10:12-14 (NIV)

But when this priest had offered for

ALL TIME ONE SACRIFICE

for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God. [13] Since that time he waits for his enemies to be made his footstool, [14] because by **ONE SACRIFICE** he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy.
