# In Washing the Disciples Feet Jesus was Pointing to...

## 1- SPIRITUAL Cleansing through His Death

Romans 3:22-25 (NIV) This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, [23] for ALL HAVE SINNED and FALL SHORT of the glory of God, [24] and are **JUSTIFIED FREELY BY HIS GRACE** through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. [25] God presented him as a sacrifice of atonement, **THROUGH FAITH IN HIS BLOOD...**

# In Washing the Disciples Feet Jesus was Pointing to...

## 2- CONFESSION and Restoration

1 John 1:9 (NIV) If we CONFESS OUR SINS, he is faithful and just and **WILL FORGIVE** us OUR SINS and **purify us from all unrighteousness.**

# **When Should We Confess Our Sins?**

- **as Soon as we are Aware of it**
- **at the End of each day**
- **at the Start of each day**

# Why Did Jesus Wash their Feet?

- to Demonstrate His **LOVE**
- as a Symbol of **FORGIVENESS** and  
Cleansing
- as a Symbol of **RESTORATION** after  
Falling
- as an example of **HUMBLE SERVICE**
