

John 14:23-25 (NLT)

[23] Jesus replied, “All who love me will do what I say. My Father will love them, and we will come and make our home with each of them. [24] Anyone who doesn’t love me will not obey me. And remember, my words are not my own. What I am telling you is from the Father who sent me. [25] I am telling you these things now while I am still with you.

John 14:26-27 (NLT)

[26] But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative - that is, the Holy Spirit - he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you. [27] “I am leaving you with a gift - peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid.

John 14:28-29 (NLT)

[28] Remember what I told you: I am going away, but I will come back to you again. If you really loved me, you would be happy that I am going to the Father, who is greater than I am. [29] I have told you these things before they happen so that when they do happen, you will believe.

John 14:15-31



**→ The Holy Spirit gives
Understanding and Reveals
God's TRUTH
(He is the Spirit of Truth)**

Deuteronomy 31:7-8 (NIV)

Then Moses summoned Joshua and said to him in the presence of all Israel, "Be strong and courageous, for you must go with this people into the land that the LORD swore to their forefathers to give them, and you must divide it among them as their inheritance. [8] **The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.**"

Hebrews 3:17-18 (Phillips)

And who was it with whom God was displeased for forty long years? Was it not those who, after all their hearing of God's Word, fell into sin, and left their bones in the desert? And to whom did God swear that they should never enter his rest?

Was it not these very men
who **REFUSED** to **TRUST HIM**?

Matthew 6:31-33 (NIV)

So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?'

[32] For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them.

[33] But **seek first his kingdom and his righteousness**, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV)

Do not be ANXIOUS about anything, but in everything, by PRAYER and petition, with THANKSGIVING, present your REQUESTS to God.

[7] And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Paul's Encouragement...

- don't **WORRY** - Pray
- don't give in to **FEAR** - Thank God
- don't **FOCUS** on your Needs - Tell them to God (Request ...NOT a Demand)

Result - Peace of GOD
that Exceed all Expectations

Truth About the Holy Spirit:

- He is with us **FOREVER**
- The world **CANNOT** accept Him
- He **LIVES IN** us
- He **TEACHES** us
- He **REMINDS** us of Jesus' words

(Life Application Bible Notes)

Before the Disciples could Fully Understand:

- Jesus had to **DIE**
- Jesus had to Rise again in **VICTORY**
- Holy Spirit had to **COME**

(Bible Know. Comm.)

→ **LOVE** and **DEVOTION**
are more powerful motivators
than **FEAR** of Punishment

Matthew 22:37-40 (NIV)

**...LOVE the Lord your God with
all your heart and with all your soul and
with all your mind. [38] This is the first and
greatest commandment. [39] And the
second is like it: 'LOVE your neighbor as
yourself.' [40] All the Law and the
Prophets hang on these two
commandments.'**

→ The best motivation for
OBEYING God's Word is
LOVE
