This, the first of his miraculous signs, Jesus performed at Cana in Galilee. He thus revealed his glory, and his disciples put their faith in him.

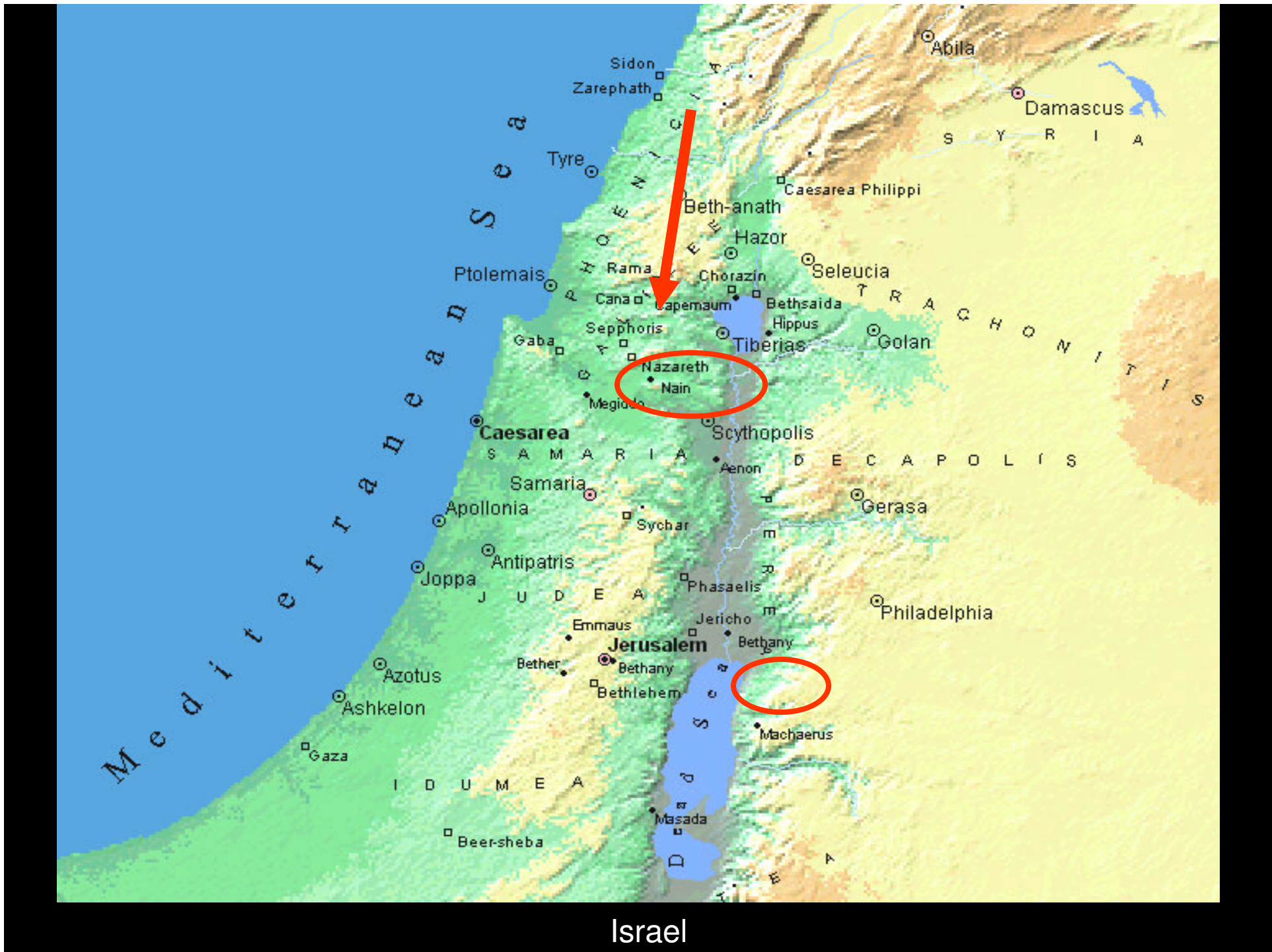
John 20:30-31 (NIV)

- **I will NOT interfere or make Demands**

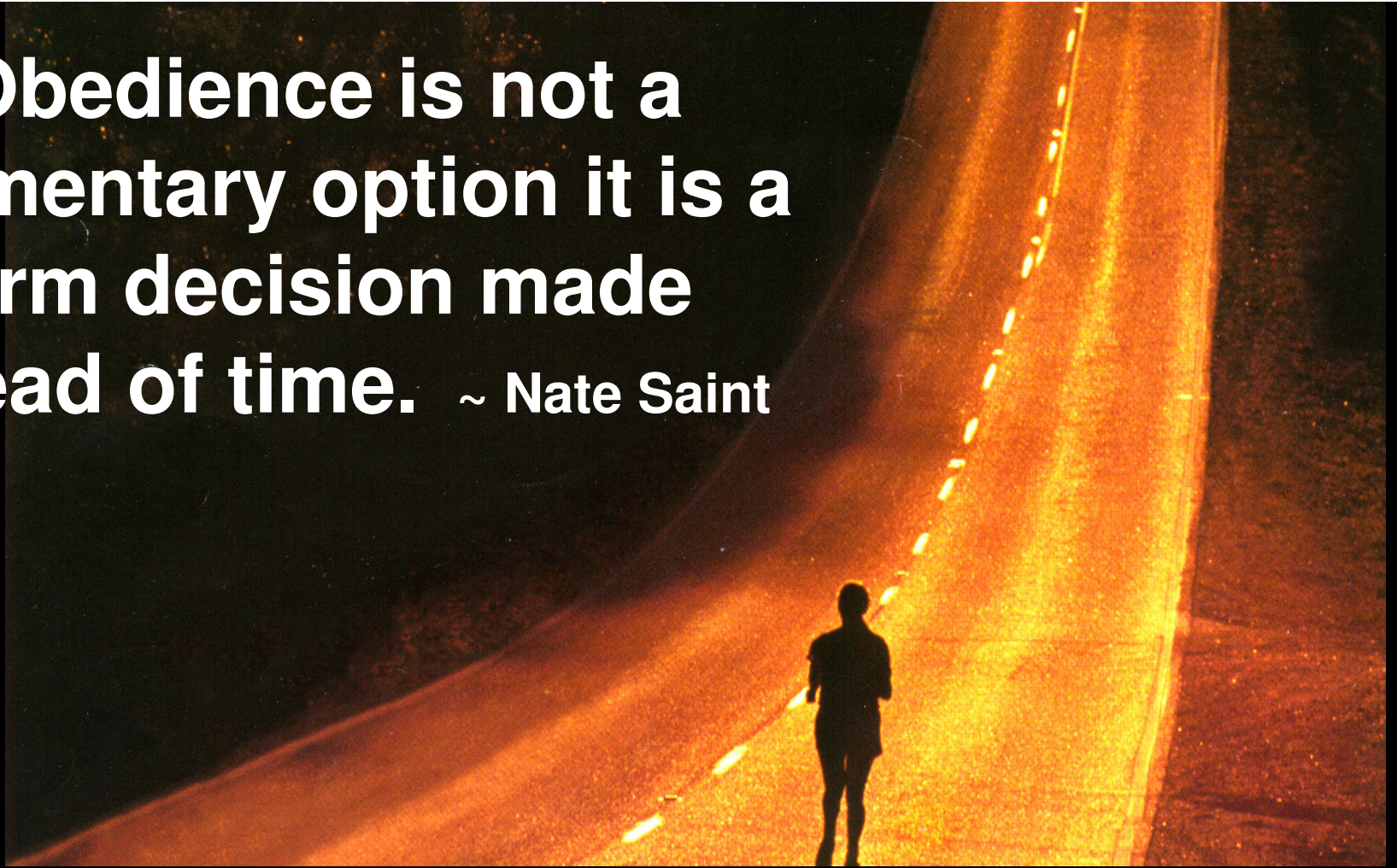
Are we Ready to Do Whatever HE Says?
