➤ **Worship as Praise - What we SAY**

Heb. 13:15 (NIV) Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise--the fruit of lips that CONFESS his name.

Luke 6:45 (NLT) ..For what you SAY flows from what is in your heart.

Luke 6:45 (ESV) ...for out of the ABUNDANCE of the heart his mouth speaks

➤ **Worship as Action - What we DO**

1 Cor. 10:31 (ESV) **So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.**

Col. 3:17 (NLT) **And whatever you DO or SAY, do it AS a REPRESENTATIVE of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through him to God the Father.**

THREE Components in Worship

➤ **Worship as Holiness - Who we ARE**

Romans 12:1-2 (JBP) With eyes wide open to the mercies of God, I beg you, my brothers, as **an act of intelligent WORSHIP**, to give him your bodies, as **a living sacrifice**, **CONSECRATED** to him and acceptable by him. Don't let the world around you squeeze you into its own mould, but let God re-mould your minds from within...

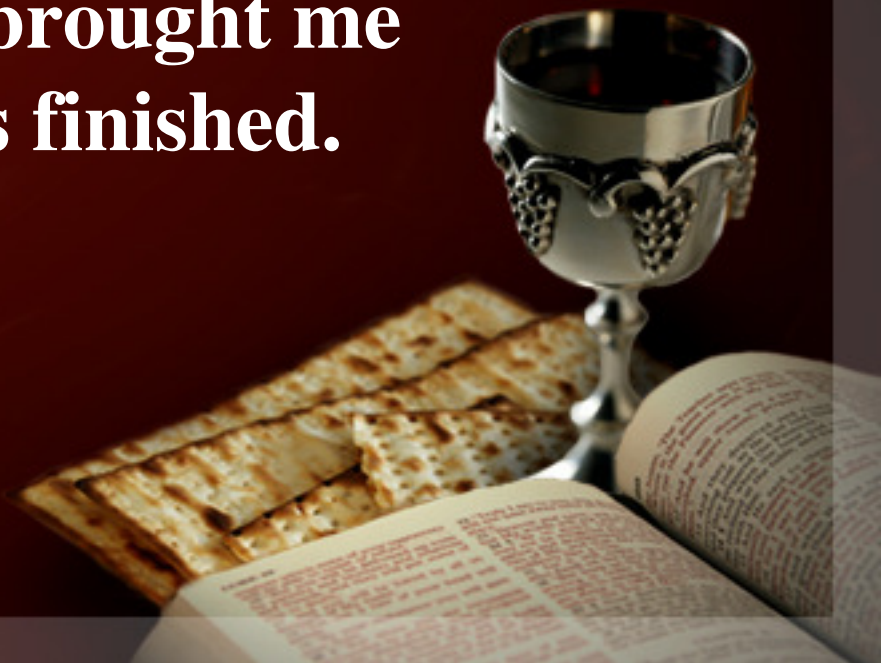
