Notes from the Pastor...

Lent is a period of time where we can try and set aside time to reflect on our spiritual selves. Have we rendered our heart to God? Have we cleansed our inner temples of the things that defile us? Are we willing to be disciples, letting go of things within our lives to follow Christ? Are we willing to grow in our obedience to how God calls us to live? Lent is definitely a time to be asking a lot of questions about ourselves and our relationship to God.

Lent can be a time where we focus on spiritual practices such as prayer, forgiveness, healing, Sabbath taking, study of the scripture, and worship. Lent can be a time of discipline and focus on sacrifice. Giving something up for Lent can be a daily reminder of Christ's sacrifice and obedience made for us.

Lent can be the time where we celebrate the good news that through Christ's obedience we are made whole with God. From 1 John 2: ¹My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. ²He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.

One way I see our lives dwelling within the framework of God's law, of

God's claim on us, of living in obedience to Jesus Christ is this:

Remember the childhood drawing toy – Spirograph? I don't know if they still make them. But a Spirograph comes with a large plastic frame and lots of different shaped circles and ovals. You take a circle, and pick a colored pen, and place the pen in one of the holes in the circle. The circle and the frame have ridges on them that link together, so when you place the circle along the frame, it rolls smoothly along. The pen makes contact with the paper underneath, and soon you have a unique image, sometimes a circle of circles, sometimes something more like a flower or maybe even a star.

In our own lives, God is the frame, God gives us laws and commands and teachings to keep us within a certain framework. But within that framework God gives us an amazing amount of space to explore our own uniqueness, our own gifts, our own way of exploring who we are in relationship to God through Jesus Christ. Take away the frame, and the circle and pen no longer make the beautiful design. During this season of Lent, I encourage you to reflect on how your life, in connection with God, touches the paper and creates amazingly unique drawing in God's sight.
