Notes from the Pastor...

Presbyterian Lingo

During the interim process we use a lot of abbreviations. Here are a few:

PNC: Pastor Nominating Committee. This is the elected group of church members that will be discerning who our future pastor will be.

COM: Committee on Ministry. This is a Presbytery Committee made up of elders and pastors. We have a COM Liaison that will work with the PNC. The COM has to approve our mission study as well as our CIF before we can begin searching for a pastor.

CIF: Church Information Form. This is the job description that potential pastor's will read to discern if they are a good fit for this particular church.

PIF: Personal Information Form: This is the form a pastor fills out for the PNC to read and discern of the candidate is a good fit.

The process:

The Interim Task Force has begun to meet. Our goal is to determine if the 2003 mission statement of the church still speaks to us today. If not, we need to write a new mission statement. Part of this process will involve a church-wide survey and a Congregation Open Forum to be held on Sunday, May 23 from 10:30-12:00. Please join us!

The PNC will meet with their COM liaison soon. They will begin to write the CIF.

Our goal: to have both the mission study and the CIF finished and approved by the end of the summer so the PNC can begin receiving PIFs in September.

DISCIPLE

BECOMING DISCIPLES
THROUGH BIBLE STUDY

BECOMING DISCIPLES THROUGH BIBLE STUDY is the foundation of the DISCIPLE Bible Study program.

DISCIPLE assumes that the bible is the key to renewal in the church. It recognizes the human-divine nature of the Bible: The actual texts of Scripture were written by human beings like ourselves in their cultural settings, under the divine inspiration of God.

DISCIPLE affirms that the canon was formed as it is in order for God to speak to us. BECOMING DISCIPLES THROUGH BIBLE STUDY gives equal time to both the Old and New Testament, emphasizing the wholeness of the Bible as the revelation of God. DISCIPLE aims at transformation, not just information, and calls on persons to submit themselves to examination by Scripture, to put themselves under the power of God's Word, and to be changed by God's Word. DISCIPLE invites persons to bring their experiences and struggles to the Scripture. All persons know something is amiss with their existence and yearn for the Word from God.

BECOMING DISCIPLES THROUGH BIBLE STUDY uses biblical language and images and draws upon the work of scholars to aid understanding of the Bible.

This study requires reading large portions of Scripture each week and is based on careful study and preparation. During the course of thirty-four weeks, groups will move through the biblical stories of Creation to the New Jerusalem. The titles of the sessions along with theme words; theme verses; and major persons, events, and topics will set the sequence of the biblical story in the minds of the participants. The principal Scripture for each session follows the chronological movement of the biblical story.
