Spiritual Gifts

We have begun the fall season of the life of the church with an emphasis on the pouring out of the Holy Spirit. God is at work here in this place with people responding to God's call to use their gifts with: Here am I!

Serving Gifts: Administration, Artistry, Faith, Giving, Hospitality, Leadership, Mercy, Service, Skilled-Craft, Healing, Miracles

Important News for Sunday School

Dear Sunday School Families and Church Families,

The Christian Education Ministry and Worship and Music Ministry recently met jointly with Reverend Morgan and discussed the involvement of the church's children regularly in Sunday morning worship. We all agreed that the inclusion of children and youth as participants in the regular worship life of the congregation is essential to the health of the church as a whole. The result of these discussions is a new schedule which will feature the children in the sanctuary for the beginning of church on some Sundays and will feature children experiencing Kids Own Worship children's church other Sundays. Following both of these experiences, children will still receive their Sunday School education in their classrooms to further their biblical understanding and faith development.

Below you will find a breakdown on a week-by-week basis of the schedule for our children:

On the First Sunday of the Month: All children Pre-K through 6th grade will begin the morning in Fellowship Hall and will experience Kids Own Worship children's church from 9:00- 9:30. From 9:30 until parents are available to pick them up, children in Pre-K through 2nd Grade will continue with their Faithweavers Sunday School Curriculum in their

classrooms. Children 3rd Grade through 6th Grade will receive Communion Education and then join the congregation for Communion. Pre-school and below will begin their mornings in the classroom as usual. Similarly, 7th grade will follow their usual Sunday morning routine.

*This schedule reflects **no change** from what has been happening the past year.*

On the Second and Third Sundays of the Month: All children will arrive at church and sit with their families. Children will come forward for the Children's Message. Children will be led in the Children's Message and Children's prayer. This will be followed by the Lord's Prayer and the singing of Jesus Loves Me. Children will then be escorted to their respective classrooms by their teachers, where they will continue with their usual Sunday morning curriculum. *This schedule reflects a change from the past year.*

On the Fourth and Possibly Fifth Sundays of the Month: All children Pre-K through 6th grade will begin the morning in Fellowship Hall and will experience Kids Own Worship children's church from 9:00- 9:30. From 9:30 until parents are available to pick them up, children in Pre-K through 6th Grade will continue with their Faithweavers Sunday School Curriculum in their classrooms. Pre-school and below will begin

their mornings in the classroom as usual. Similarly, 7th grade will follow their usual Sunday morning routine. *This schedule reflects **no change** from what has been happening the past year.*

As you can see, the change is currently only being instituted on the second and third Sundays of the month. It is our hope to incorporate music, bell choirs and baptisms into this time so that our children can participate more fully in the experience of worship.

As with many changes that occur in weekly routine, this schedule may cause some initial uncertainty in terms of who belongs where and when. Rest assured we will do all we can to clearly indicate on each Sunday what will be happening with your children. We believe the result will be well worth the effort.

Thank you for your anticipated cooperation and enthusiasm in incorporating children in the worship experience and life of our congregation. If you are interested in discussing this further, please feel free to contact Susan Cate and Becca Swope of the Christian Education Ministry.

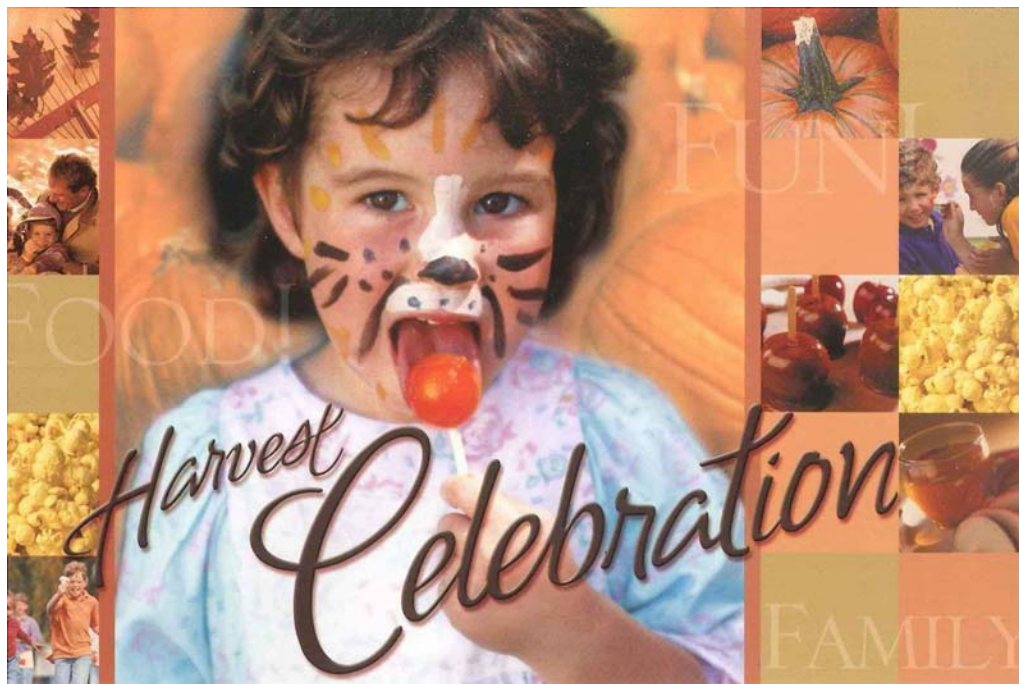
