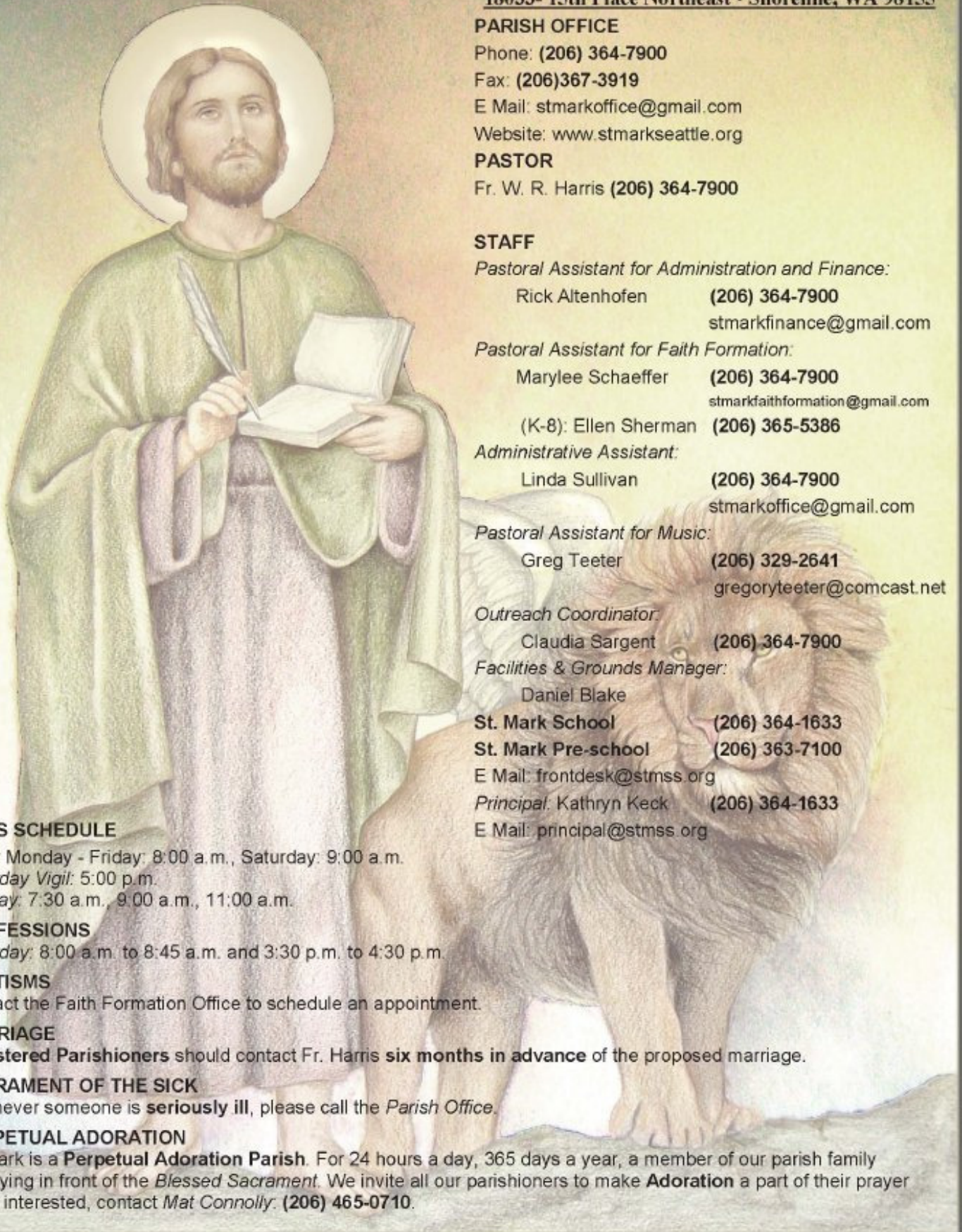

What does following Jesus really mean?

The theme of today's readings is discipleship and how, when a person accepts the challenge to be a disciple, change occurs in that person's life. Whether we consider Elisha in the first reading or the three persons in the Gospel who were invited to follow Jesus, one thing is common to all. Their lives changed remarkably when they agreed to take up the role of disciple. In the Gospel we meet three different people who encounter Jesus and know themselves to be called to follow Him. Jesus encourages some and speaks discouraging words to others. But in every case He points to the essence of being a disciple: keeping your eyes focused on the goal of proclaiming the reign of God.

The call to discipleship continues today, a call directed to all Christians who, by their baptism, are bound to proclaim God's presence in their lives. In the Eucharist we are reminded of this vocation and fed with the bread of life which strengthens us to be the hands, the feet, the eyes, and the mouth of God by the way we love our neighbor. This is the essence of Christian discipleship.

PERPETUAL ADORATION

This coming Friday, July 2, is First Friday, so Adoration will take place in the church, instead of the chapel, from the end of Mass on Friday, July 2, until the start of Mass on Saturday, July 3. Have you ever wondered why Exposition is made available to everyone in this fashion on the first Friday of every month? This devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus was established by Jesus when he revealed Himself to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1674. In this series of visions, Jesus asked St. Margaret Mary to make a Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament and receive Communion on the first Fridays of nine consecutive months, for the ingratitude of man and their sins against Jesus. Among His promises, Jesus states, "In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the Sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour." Of course there is much more to this devotion, but this might give you the foundation to research it further. And considering that July 2 is the First Friday following the Feast of the Sacred Heart (June 11 this year), this could be the most appropriate of First Fridays to start your devotion. Mat Connolly

[Report shows \\$1 billion in US taxpayer money has gone to abortion industry](#)

A report released by the non-partisan Government Accountability Office (GAO) reveals over \$1 billion in U.S. taxpayer money going to organizations that promote or provide abortions, including Planned Parenthood.

The 33-page report was requested by Rep. Pete Olson (R-Texas), and strongly supported by Rep. Chris Smith (R-NJ), as well as other members of Congress.

The report discovered that six organizations connected to the abortion industry received over a billion dollars in federal funds between 2002 and 2009. The organizations include Planned Parenthood Federation of America, International Planned Parenthood Federation, Population Council of the United States, Guttmacher Institute, Advocates for Youth and Sexuality Information and Education Council of the United States. Planned Parenthood Federation of America alone received \$657.1 million in federal funding." A significant portion of federal taxpayer funding for domestic activities was provided through grants under the Title X program which provides grants for family planning," stated Rep. Smith's press release. "This program provides a

funding source that helps abortionists set up clinics that do family planning in one room and abortion in the next."

"The most unsafe place for women and children today is Planned Parenthood's 850 facilities. At Planned Parenthood clinics, in 2007 alone, 305,000 babies were either dismembered, chemically poisoned, or starved to death by RU486."

"Since Obama's election, U.S. subsidies to the abortion industry at home and abroad, have significantly increased," Smith continued, saying: "When Obama shredded the Mexico City Policy, he opened the floodgate of taxpayer funds to pro-abortion NGOs (non-governmental organizations) like the International Planned Parenthood Federation, that perform and lobby for abortion worldwide. Obama increased funding to those organizations by 50%, or to \$648,457 million." "It's time for Americans and especially Congress ... to de-fund it," Smith concluded. Ken Blackwell, Family Research Council Senior Fellow for Family Empowerment, stated that "When taxpayer money goes to abortion groups for any reason, it supports the work of the abortion industry. We should not let abortion companies benefit financially from taxpayer funds." Blackwell urged Congress to "bring an end to funding for abortion providers by enacting the "Title X Abortion Provider Prohibition Act." he said. It was introduced in early referring to it as a "commonsense bill which would simply ensure that funds go to organizations that are not in the abortion business." "Voters have said they do not want their tax dollars supporting this industry, yet Members of Congress defy their constituents by voting to channel tax dollars to abortion providers, like Planned Parenthood," said Marjorie Dannenfelser, president of the Susan B. Anthony List, a network committed to advancing pro-life women in the political process. "Women, the unborn and the American people deserve better than this," she said. (CNA) / June 17, 2010

[New 'Ella' drug should be labeled an abortion pill, argues pro-life leader](#)

A new drug, which has received the FDA's safety approval, is being described as a "morning-after" pill. However, the drug, "Ella," which will most likely be approved for U.S. distribution, has received criticism from numerous sources on its similarity to the abortion drug, RU-486. Steve Mosher, director of Population Research Institute, said that "greed" on the part of the pharmaceutical company is one of the major factors in the situation, given that distribution of the drug would be limited were it labeled an abortifacient (causing an abortion). "There is little doubt that the 'Ella' pill acts as an abortifacient in nearly all cases," wrote Mosher. They get around this by redefining what a pregnancy is, he said. They claim instead that "pregnancy does not begin at conception, but only at the implantation into the uterine wall of the developing embryo, five to seven days later," he noted. "This is a misleading and inaccurate definition of pregnancy [which begins at conception, when egg and sperm unite.]" "Planned Parenthood - an organization that would profit off the new drug - claims that there is no evidence that the drug interrupts pregnancy after implantation," Mosher stated. "But it almost surely does," he explained, "since it blocks the progesterone receptors necessary for the early development of the embryo to continue." "The test which women are given to determine whether they are suffering a miscarriage is one which measures the amount of progesterone," the pro-life leader clarified. "A progesterone-killing drug will also necessarily be an embryo-killing drug." "This is another kind of abortion pill and should be clearly labeled as such if it is approved at all," Mosher asserted.
