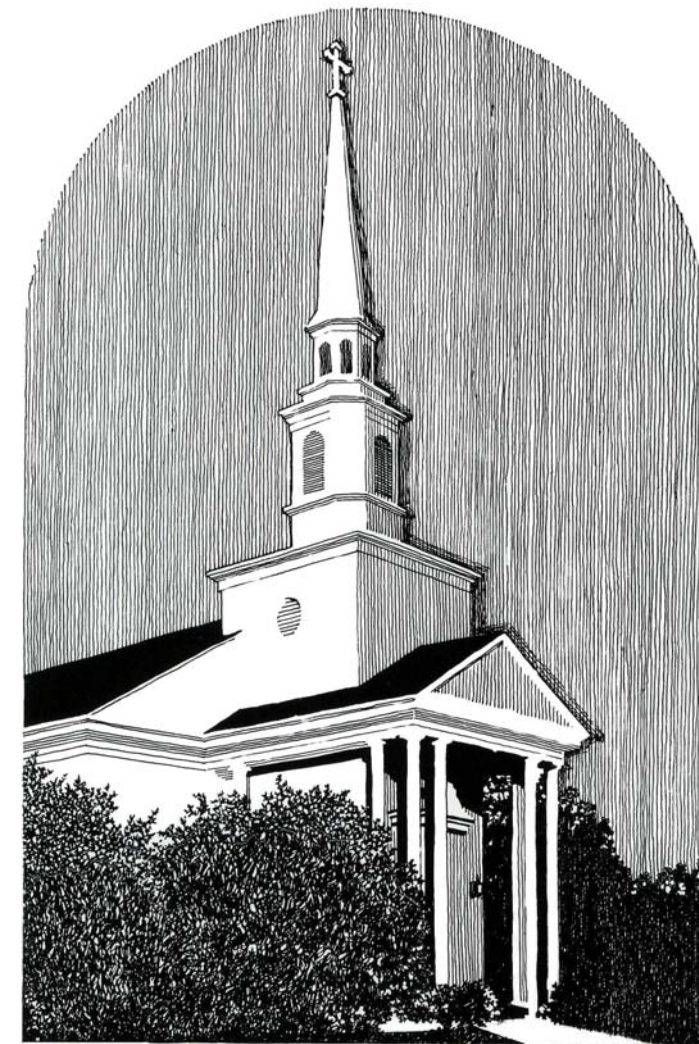
### NEWS AND SUCH
