Automotive Policies for Youth Group Travel

Whenever private automobiles are used for travel from Wright Community Congregational United Church of Christ for Youth events and activities the following policies apply:

1. All automobiles are to be driven by persons 25 years of age or older
2. No automobile may carry more persons than its rated capacity. It is assumed that an automobile will have at least one seatbelt per occupant
3. Seatbelts will be worn by all occupants at all times that the automobile is in motion
4. All traffic regulations, including speed limits, will be followed.

When private automobiles are used to transport youth to and from Wright Community Congregational United Church of Christ, the following policies apply:

1. Youth may drive their own automobiles to and from the church if they have permission from a parent or guardian and a current driver's license
2. Youth may not transport any other youth in their automobile. Youth may transport their sibling(s) to and from the church with the permission of their parents or guardian.
3. No automobile may carry more persons than its rated capacity. It is assumed that an automobile will have at least one seatbelt per occupant
4. Seatbelts will be worn by all occupants at all times that the automobile is in motion.
5. All Traffic regulations, including speed limits, will be followed.
